

The story of God part 1 (The Old Testament)

Week 1

Day 1: Genesis 1-3 (Creation of the world. Sin gets involved and messes everything up)

Day 2: Genesis 4,6-7 (God's creation becomes really evil really fast)

Day 3: Genesis 8-9, Gen. 11:1-9 (The world starts over again after the flood. People instantly become evil again)

Day 4: Genes 12,15, 16 (God promises an old man ([Abraham]) that he will turn him into a great nation some day. The nation of Israel)

Day 5: Genesis 18-19 (God destroys the towns Sodom and Gomorrah because they were evil)

Day 6: Genesis 21:1-21, Gen 22:1-19 (Isaac born and almost killed to test Abraham) Day 7: Genesis 24 (Isaac marries Rebekah)

Week 2

Day 1: Genesis 25:19-34, Gen. 27 (Jacob steals his brother Esau's blessing. Jacob renamed Israel)

Day 2: Genesis 37,39-40 (Joseph has a miserable life and can't catch a break)

Day 3: Genesis 41-42 (Joseph's rise to power in Egypt)

Day 4: Genesis 43-45 (Joseph toys with his brothers and then reveals himself to be Joseph)

Day 5: Genesis 47, 50 (Joseph's brothers move to Egypt and Joseph dies)

Day 6: Exodus 1-3 (Israel are now slaves in Egypt and Moses is born)

Day 7: Exodus 4-6:12 (Moses and God trying to get Israelites out of Egypt)

Week 3

Day 1: Exodus 7-10 (The nine plagues on Egypt)

Day 2: Exodus 11-12 (The final plague and leaving Egypt)

Day 3: Exodus 14, 16, 17:1-7 (Israel crosses the red sea and God has to provide in the wilderness)

Day 4: Exodus 20:1-21, Ex. 32 (Ten commandments and Israel worships golden calf)

Day 5: Exodus 33-34 (Moses gets to talk to God face to not face)

Day 6: Joshua 1-2 (Joshua takes over for Moses)

Day 7: Joshua 3, 6 (The Israelites finally make it to the promised land God promised Abraham so long ago)

Week 4:

Day 1: Judges 3:5-31, Jdg. 4 (The judges of Israel were super cool warriors!)

Day 2: Judges 6-7 (Gideon called to fight against those worshipping idols)

Day 3: Judges 14-16, Jdg. 21:25 (Samson kicks the Philistine's butts)

Day 4: 1 Samuel 1, 3 (The prophet [someone who speaks for God] Samuel is born)

Day 5: 1 Samuel 8-10 (Israel demands a king even though God was already king. King Saul is appointed 1st king of Israel)

Day 6: 1 Samuel 13:1-15, 1 Sam. 15, 1 Samuel 16 (Saul is an evil king and God declares a new king will take over soon. This king [King David] will love God and do good)

Day 7: 1 Samuel 17-18 (David begins to win the hearts of the people over Saul even though he's not king yet.)

Week 5:

Day 1: 1 Samuel 19-20 (Saul tries to kill David because he's jealous of him. Saul's son Jonathan is friends with David and saves his life. David begins to hide from Saul.)

Day 2: 1 Samuel 24, 26, 31 (David has the chance to kill Saul twice but doesn't because he couldn't strike down who God made king. He must revere God. Saul dies.)

Day 3: 2 Samuel 5, 7 (God tells David he will give him a kingdom that will last forever and that his son Solomon will build a temple for Him.)

Day 4: 2 Samuel 11-12:24 (David sins by committing adultery with a married woman and having her husband killed. He's confronted by a prophet and asks for forgiveness. God forgives, but the son born dies. His son, Solomon is born.)

Day 5: 2 Samuel 15-17 (David's son Absalom tries to overthrow him as king but fails)

Day 6: 1 Kings 1:28-52, 1 Kings 2 (David dies. Solomon, David's son, is made king)

Day 7: 1 Kings 3, 4:29-34 (Solomon's wisdom)

Week 6:

Day 1: 1 Kings 8 (Solomon builds the temple as THE place where people come to worship and hear from God.)

Day 2: 1 Kings 17-18 (After a lot of other kings have come and gone since Solomon, Israel has become very evil. The false god named Baal has become the people's object of worship. Elijah the Prophet shows up to confront the prophets of Baal.)

Day 3: 2 Kings 2, 4-5 (Elisha takes over for Elijah and does a LOT of miracles)

Day 4: 2 Chronicles 36:15-22, Daniel 1 (Lots of Israel's kings were very evil and the people of Israel were very evil. So God sent many prophets to tell the people to change their ways or something bad would happen. When they wouldn't listen, God's promise was that they would be taken captive and Israel [including the temple] would be destroyed by Babylon.)

Day 5: Daniel 2 (Daniel is one of the Israelites that were taken captive to live in Babylon. The king of Babylon, Nebuchadnezzar, had a dream that Daniel interprets)

Day 6: Daniel 3, 6 (The fiery furnace and the lion's den)

Day 7: Daniel 7-8, 12 (Daniel has a dream about the future all the way up to the end of the world where he says God will establish a kingdom)

Week 7:

Day 1: Ezra 1:1-5, Ezra 3:7-13 (The people finally return to Israel out of captivity in Babylon and rebuild the temple)

Day 2: Ezra 9-10 (The people recognize how they have displeased God and repent)

Day 3: Nehemiah 1-2 (Nehemiah gets a burden from the Lord to rebuild the walls of fallen Jerusalem. Artaxerxes sends him back to fix it.)

Day 4: Nehemiah 8-9 (The people find the book of the law and repent)

Day 5: Malachi 1-2 (God angry with Israel for their history of rebelling against Him)

Day 6: Malachi 3-4 (God will save His people from their sins and make a new covenant with them. It will start with "Elijah" who will prepare the people for the day of the Lord)
