The Empty Tomb

John 20:1-18 | Jason Krute, Senior Pastor

March 31, 2024

The following outline includes points to help you identify the main ideas in the passage. I have provided answers to get you started, but feel free to expand or write your own.

Outlining John 20:1-18

Characters and/or setting: The setting of this section of Scripture is at the tomb of Christ's burial. People present at various times include Mary Magdalene, Peter, John, two angels, and the risen Jesus.

Topic, conflict, or focus: The main conflict is the confusion caused by an empty tomb. Where did the body go?

Key message or lesson: This is the beginning of Jesus revealing His power over death. Mary Magdalene gets to see this for herself, and Jesus will continue to reveal himself to others over the next 40 days.

Lessons about Jesus as God: Jesus' claim to be God is confirmed by His resurrection. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 15 that this event is the key evidence that Christ is the Savior. Without a resurrection, we worship in vain.

Questions or follow-up:

Practical application: What will you do with a resurrected Christ? Will you believe He is God or mock the account?
