Paul's Calling Ephesians 3:1-13 | Jason Krute. Senior Pastor

Encouragement Towards Unity

- ...For this reason I, Paul...
 - transition word tying a motive to an action; specifically in this letter Paul has talked about God unifying all people under the salvation of Jesus Christ (motive) which caused Paul to pray blessing and protection over the church (action)
 - Paul does not start his action until verse 14, where he starts a prayer over the church (next week's sermon)
- ...a prisoner of Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles...
 - Paul is physically a prisoner of Rome, but sees the authority of Jesus Christ even in a negative situation
 - Acts 13:44-49 is where we see Paul's focus move to the Gentiles (Paul will still minister in many synagogues, so Jews are not excluded from Paul's various missionary journeys.)
- ...this mystery is that the Gentiles are fellow heirs...
 - a reiteration of one Gospel; Jew and Gentile partake in the salvation of Christ and Christ alone
- ...of this gospel I was made a minister...
 - reiterates Paul's conversion and calling as an apostle
 - remind yourself of Paul's miraculous conversion from old self to new self; reread Acts 8-9
- ...I ask you not to lose heart over what I am suffering for you...
 - even if Jews want to celebrate Paul's imprisonment, Paul wants the Ephesus church (especially his Gentile brothers and sisters) to keep their hope focused on the Gospel and the unity that Christ brings
