Bread of Life

John 6:22-59 | Jason Krute, Senior Pastor

The following outline includes points to help you identify the main ideas in the passage. I have provided answers to get you started, but feel free to expand or write your own.

Outlining John 6:22-59

Characters and/or setting: This story involves Jesus and the crowd that was fed along the Sea of Galilee.

Topic, conflict, or focus: The conflict in this story centers on the crowd wanting more food and Jesus' desire to turn the physical provisions into spiritual provisions.

Key message or lesson: Jesus declares He is the bread of life. It is belief in Him that gives eternal life. Jesus is repeatedly stressing that eternal life is through faith in the Son of God.


Lessons about Jesus as God: Jesus quotes from Isaiah declaring He is the Word that draws people to God.

Questions or follow-up:

Practical application: Are you really a disciple or do you just like God's stuff?
