Jesus and John

John 21:20-25 | Jason Krute, Senior Pastor

The following outline includes points to help you identify the main ideas in the passage. I have provided answers to get you started, but feel free to expand or write your own.

O	utl	ini	na	John	21	:2	O-	25

Characters and/or setting: Jesus and Peter have a conversation in which John is referenced.

Topic, conflict, or focus: As the book closes, the topics include Peter's curiosity about John, John's clarifying of Jesus' words, and John declaring this Gospel to be his testimony.

Key message or lesson: John closes his book, possibly knowing he is the last living apostle, with a declaration that everything within was experienced by the author.

Lessons about Jesus as God: John admits that Jesus did many more things that point to His deity, but they are too numerous for one book.

Questions or follow-up:

Practical application: What did you learn from John?

MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK Kyle McEachron - Teach Beyond, Hungary



Kyle is engaged in full-time ministry, teaching art and graphic design classes at the International Christian School of Budapest in Hungary (ICSB). Originally Kyle committed to spending two years in Hungary, and the congregation approved his initial two-year commitment. Kyle has chosen to pursue long-term ministry in Hungary. This requires a new vote at our Mid-Year Congregational Meeting on May 5. The Missions Board recommends continuing support for Kyle and adding him to our list of long-term missionaries. In addition to

teaching art and graphic design, next year Kyle is considering teaching a Christian Studies elective, and will also be taking Hungarian language lessons.

As you pray for Kyle, praise God for his decision to continue God's calling to this ministry. Pray for wisdom about the Christian Studies elective next year, which would stretch him.
