UKRAINIAN RELIEF

In February of 2022, the Russian invasion of Ukraine began, bringing unimagined devastation, destruction, and death. As the days, weeks, and months have passed, we at GCC have grieved, prayed, and given to help Ukrainian refugees through trusted partners in and near Ukraine. Now, almost 6 months later, 8 million Ukrainian people are internally displaced within Ukraine and another 6.5 million refugees have fled into neighboring countries.



As these refugees spread throughout Europe, we have GCC missionaries and trusted partners who were already in position and now have opportunities to reach out by meeting practical needs for food, clothing, and other supplies as well as spiritual needs for peace, hope, and a Savior. For example, the McAtees have had the opportunity to serve some of these refugees in Athens by supporting a Ukrainian pastor there who is reaching out to the 50,000 plus new refugees. Another trusted partner in Budapest, Hungary, is organizing food and resource distribution and helping with church plants among Ukrainian refugees who have flooded the area.

Change for Change in August will be used to help GCC missionaries and trusted partners as they work to meet the needs of the Ukrainian people in their areas. Just place your donation (marked Ukraine) in an offering box in the church concourse or give online.
