The Persecuted—Extended

Matthew 5:11-12 | Jason Krute, Senior Pastor

Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you. (ESV)

What do you face?

revile you - to assail with abusive words, to slander; to shame unjustly

-Pattern is similar to 1 Peter 4:14; 1 Samuel 17:10, 36; Psalm 42:10, 74:10, 18, 102:8, 119:42 (OT quotes from the Septuagint.)

persecuted - to pursue and harass; usually with an intent to harm

-Pattern is similar to Acts 7:51-53, 9:4-5, 22:3-8; Galatians 1:13; 2 Timothy 3:10-13.

evil against you - deliberately lie to discredit, no matter how egregious

-Pattern is similar to Matthew 9:1-8 (4).

How should I handle this?

You rejoice by reminding yourself your identity is in the Gospel.

You rejoice that your reputation is committed to the Lord.

You rejoice that you are not the first person to experience slander.

Questions for the week:

- 1. How often do you evaluate whether your habits align with God's righteousness?
- 2. Are you holding your friend group accountable if they are the source of insult and evil against others?

MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK M AND M Undisclosed

M and M have served in an undisclosed location that has been hostile to the gospel. Last year, they moved to a new city. Due to various circumstances happening in their organization and the educational needs of their children, they have made the difficult decision to return to the U.S. This decision has seemed to come very suddenly, even to them, especially after recently moving to a new city; but after much prayer, thinking, and counsel with godly mentors, they have decided that this is what the Lord would have them do. They moved back to the U.S in December. With their language and cultural experience and their heart for the lost, they plan to continue serving refugees and making trips back to the community where they served.

As you pray for M and M, praise God for their 15 years of ministry. Pray for their transition back to the U.S., and specifically for a reliable used car.
