Authority Over Disease

Mark 1:29-45 | Jason Krute, Senior Pastor

Below are simple summaries of topics found within each passage of Scripture. A great way to see the flow of Scripture is to summarize what you have read in your own words. Feel free to add your summaries to the ones provided here.

- 1:29-31 Jesus shows care and compassion for individuals and their needs.
- 1:32-34 Jesus has authority over sickness and disease, but the masses do not seem interested in a relationship with Christ.
- 1:35-37 Jesus prioritizes quiet time (isolation) and prayer with God the Father.
- 1:38-39 Jesus states a clear focus—He has come to teach repentance and belief in the gospel. (Jesus specifically says He has come to preach, which is the message that was stated in 1:15.)
- 1:40-44 Jesus again shows care and compassion to an individual by restoring the leper to cleanliness.
- 1:45 The former leper ignores Jesus and proclaim His deeds. Was this a positive or a negative for Christ's ministry?
