WHAT? Keep free from the love of money

1. This is a mark of spiritual health and maturity.
(1 Timothy 3:3,8)

2. The problem is : dishonest gain (1 Timothy 3:8)

greed (Colossians 3:5)

idolatry (1 Timothy 6:9-10)

HOW? Contentment keeps us free from love of money.

Understand the difference in needs and wants. (1 Timothy 6:6-8)

WHY? We can rest in God's promises.

1. His presence (Joshua 1:5)

2. His help (Psalm 118:6)

Luke 12:15 - Life is not measured by how much you own.

Romans 8:31-32 - If God give us the precious jewel, won't He also give the box?

Philippians 4:11-13 - Contentment is empowered by Jesus.

Psalm 23 - I will not fret over what I do not have, but rather, give thanks that God meets my needs.
