vs 1 - Satan, our adversary, is the accuser. (Revelation 12:10)

The devil slanders God to people and people to God.  
1 Peter 5:8; Genesis 3:4-5

vs 2 - God has power and authority over Satan.

Do not fight Satan in your own strength. (Jude 9).

vs 3 - Satan rejoices in our sin and failure.

vs. 4-5 In Christ we are clean and righteous.

Colossians 1:13-14 - delivered, transferred, redeemed, forgiven.

vs 6-7 - Salvation is unconditional, but opportunity to serve is based upon submission and faithfulness.

\*What can we do about this enemy?

1. Resist him remaining firm in your faith. (1 Peter 5:9)

2. Since this is a Spiritual battle, stand in truth.

(2 Corinthians 10:3-5; Romans 12:2)

3. Resist him by submitting to God. (James 4:7-10)

4. Be strong in God's strength: in truth, righteousness, and faith.  
(Ephesians 6:10-19)
