- ▶ “Already but not yet” - Jesus has already been given authority. but every knee has not yet bowed (Philippians 2:9-11)

- ▶ Therefore, the Great Commission is to go and make disciples.

- ▶ A disciple is a follower or student of a teacher, leader or philosopher.

Personal - A relationship, not a program.
(Mark 3:14, I Corinthians 1:9)

Process - “baptizing and teaching”
Baptism in the Name is identification as a follower of the Trinity.
Teaching is both formal and informal, and includes modeling.
The process moves a disciple from one level to the next.

Purpose - “to obey all that I commanded”

The purpose is spiritual maturity and a Christ-like life.
(Luke 6:40; 2 Corinthians 3:18)
