Scott

I was raised in a church-going family and always believed that God existed, but it wasn't until my freshman year of college that I understood that salvation is found in a personal relationship with God through Christ. Some friends involved with Campus Crusade for Christ consistently shared with me their love for and faith in Christ, and I was very attracted to it. One night as I was reading alone in bed, I became preoccupied with the question of where I would go when I died. It became very clear to me that in all my years of going to church, I had never asked Christ to be my Savior, never having put my trust in Him to pay for my sins and to give me His righteousness. That night, I trusted Christ and asked Him into my life. Three years later during a missions conference in my church up in Kirksville, I sensed the Lord calling me into missions. In 1986 I joined the staff of CCC and in 1994 Jayne and I answered the Lord's call to come to Croatia – we've been here ever since.

Jayne

My father is a pastor and so growing up in a pastor's family I always heard about God and our need to trust Christ as our Savior. At the very young age of four I felt like I understood the basic concepts of sin and my need for forgiveness, and I asked Christ into my heart. I was always very involved in our church, teaching younger kids in Sunday School or discipling younger girls. As a teenager, I went on a TEEN Mission trip to England and it was then that I felt the Lord calling me into full-time missions. I met Scott while serving with Arab World Ministries in Germany. After returning to the U.S. to get my Masters Degree, I joined the staff of CCC and soon after answered the Lord's call to go to Croatia. We truly love what the Lord gives us to do here and are so thankful for His leading in our lives!
