Over the years Solomon and Ruby have seen many of them return to their homes as top leaders and bearers of God's grace to a needy world.

Besides several articles Solomon has published two books: 1. *God's Will is About Closed Doors*. 2. *Every Tongue and Nation: Cultural Diversity in the Church Today*. He is currently working on his third book.
