Mark's Testimony:

I grew up in a Christian home. We were at church whenever the doors were open. I'm thankful for the church in which I grew up, it is there that I learned the basics of Christianity and the Bible. But, it wasn't until I went to college that I started to attend a church that really challenged me in my own personal faith. It was in college that I really started to grow spiritually and to really understand that being a Christian was more than just going to church and singing in the choir, but a living faith. In college my walk with the Lord deepened and my faith grew.

I have been a believer for nearly 35 years...more than three fourths of my life. I love the Lord and am thankful to say that, although I am far from perfect, I have never doubted my faith. I depend on my Heavenly Father and trust Him with all my heart. I seek to follow Him and I desire to grow in my walk with Him day by day.
