The Biblical Mandate to Spread the Gospel to the Unreached

- The biblical why of unreached peoples!

Revelation 5:9 - Worthy are You to take the scroll and open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood, you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.

Matthew 28:19-20a - Go therefore and make disciples of **all nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.

Panta ta Ethne - is the Koine Greek origin of what translates in English as "all nations."

Ethno - linguistic groups - "A **group** of people that share a language, common ethnicity, and cultural heritage."

Unreached - people groups with less than 2% of Jesus followers within their group, and therefore unable to sustain any measure of indigenous evangelization, discipleship, church formation and sustainable growth without external foreign support.

Unengaged - a people without any known presence of Jesus as Lord and Savior among them. They are often referred to as 'abandoned' with no Gospel witness.

Engaged - a people group is engaged when a church planting strategy, consistent with Evangelical faith and practice, is under active and consistent implementation. (In this respect, a people group is not engaged when it has been merely adopted, is the object of focused prayer, or is part of an advocacy strategy.)

Matthew 14:14 - And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come.
