Kentucky Mountain Mission:

KMM is located in the mountains of eastern Kentucky, where for over 60 years it has ministered in various ways, including church planting, community work, jail ministries, public school ministries, and Youth Haven Bible Camp. Lee County has been identified as one of the poorest counties in the country, and drug addiction has become one of the biggest problems we face. We minister to many children from broken homes and terrible home situations, and we seek to show them God's love.

We have both been very active in the ministries of Youth Haven Bible Camp for our entire career, where Steve has served as camp program director for over 10 years. He also is the maintenance director during the off season, where he, along with a co-worker is responsible for maintenance on the buildings, grounds and vehicles. Diana is the music director during the camping season, and is involved in much of the preparation for the camp program each year, including decorations, skits, music, etc. She is also the mission bookkeeper, usually spending 2 days a week in the mission office year around.

We also minister at Idamay Bible Church, where Steve works with the teens, and Diana works with the grade-school children. Steve also occasionally fills the pulpit at Idamay and in other mission churches when needed.
